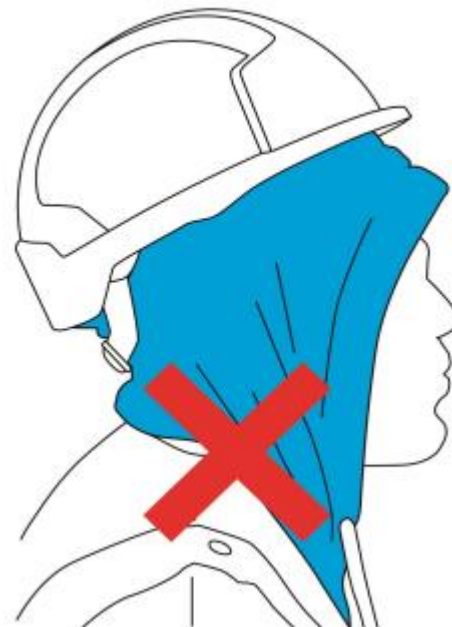

Winter PPE – Hoodies and Beanie Hats

The weather is getting colder and with this, our Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must keep us warm and dry. Without PPE that is suitable for the weather conditions, we run the risk of illness, increased fatigue or exasperating previous health conditions.

However, with the recent change in weather, we have seen numerous issues with staff wearing hoodies and/or beanie hats underneath their protective hard hats – **THIS IS PROHIBITED**



If you want to stay warm, make sure your sponsor orders the appropriate Thermal Helmet Liners that do not impair hearing or visibility or Industry Balaclavas with perforated holes around the ears.

It is the Supervisors' responsibility to ensure that their staff are complying with PPE requirements. Failure to adhere to this will result in the Supervisor of that team being issued a Yellow Card due to them not fulfilling their duties.
